

Dear Parkmont Families,

Below you will find health and dental forms. **We ask that you return these forms no later than August 10, 2020 by emailing them to office@parkmont.org.**

The forms are fillable PDF documents. We hope this makes it easier to get these completed and returned to us. However, the health and dental do require the physician/dentist signatures. You will also receive the **Emergency Contact Form in a separate email**. Please send it back to us **as soon as possible, but no later than August 10**.

In compliance with the DC Health Department, all students entering and attending school in the District of Columbia are required to complete a Universal Health Certificate, Oral Health Assessment Form, and show documented proof of correctly spaced immunizations or proof of medical or religious exemption (Immunization of School Students Act of 1979 - DC Law 3-20, and DCMR Title 22, Chapter 1). Please note that the immunization regulations were revised in 2008 to include new immunization requirements.

Health Forms include Health History, Physical Examination, Dental Appraisal, Immunization, and Tuberculosis and Lead Screening Certification. Forms are due no later than **August 10, 2020**.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- The district requires that all students submit **proof of a physical exam annually**.
- **If your child had a physical exam after September 3, 2019, and you are unable to schedule an appointment this summer, you must contact the office to let us know when your child's physical will be scheduled.**
- Immunizations: **All students are required to submit proof of updated immunizations to attend school.** See included list of immunization requirements. The HPV vaccine is required for all students entering 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. Parents requesting an HPV vaccine refusal certificate or a religious exemption form for immunizations may contact the office (office@parkmont.org) to obtain one.
- **All students need an updated TB test.**
- Updated dental forms are required for all students. Dental visits should occur every 6 months.

- All health forms require a doctor's signature, so make sure to set up an appointment and return them to us no later than **August 10, 2020**.
- **Your child will not be able to start school on Tuesday, September 8 unless all forms are up-to-date.**
